

THE PURPOSE AND POWER OF PRAYER

1 Timothy 2:1-4

¹Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, ²for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. ³For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour, ⁴who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Here, Paul wants his readers to understand that they should not be so wrapped up in their own needs and their own desires that they do not fulfil their responsibility to reach out to others through prayer asking God that thev (the unbelievers) might receive the same of that measure grace themselves enjoy - the forgiveness of sins, the indwelling Spirit of Christ, and the hope of eternal glory. There is a great purpose in prayer, and its effects can be powerful indeed.

In the late 18th Century, the power and influence of the church was in serious decline. In England, preachers and people were pelted with stones if they dared to testify to Christ. France was working through a bloody revolution and its leaders declared that religion was only a system for the oppression of the human spirit.

For forty years a Scot by the name Erskine had John encouraging Christians everywhere, through a series of pamphlets, to revival. Finally, pray for Christmas day in 1781, God broke through in a little church in Cornwall during the 3:00am prayer service. They stayed on till 9:00am and then came back in the evening. By March the following year they were praying regularly until midnight. When John Wesley visited the area in 1784 he wrote, "This country is all on fire and it is spreading from village to village."

Whole denominations doubled, then tripled, then quadrupled in numbers and the movement spread throughout the empire, North America, and some third-world countries.

In 1857, New York was in a state of depression. Businesses were closing, churches were closing and crime was rampant. Jeremiah Lamphier started a prayer meeting that within a few months attracted over 10,000 people. In two years, the revival had added 100,000 new believers to the church.

In March 1857 a few men gathered to pray in the schoolhouse in Kells, County Antrim. By September the following year, there were fifty. In 1859, 20,000 people gathered in Belfast to pray for the whole of Ireland. This saw the harvest of an estimated 100,000 souls.


You may have heard of Pastor Larry Lea's "Church of the Rock" in Rockwall Texas. In 1980, there were 13 people total. In 1988 there were 11,000. Larry says, "I didn't start a church – I started a prayer meeting. Years later, they still held their prayer meetings, Monday to Friday, at 5am.

Why do they do this? Because they know something that we often overlook – that the church that is prayerless is powerless; that the church that is not on its prayer-mat is on its death-bed. They also do it because they understand what Paul was saying to Timothy in verses 5 & 6 of the same chapter.

For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all.

There is only one God. There is only one Mediator. There is only one gospel. There is only one way to eternal life.

If we do not pray for all men (and women) and those in authority; if we do not take seriously the fact that they are in mortal and eternal danger; if we do not care where they spend eternity; if we do not care enough to see them rescued, to see them saved from darkness and sin, to see them brought into the kingdom of light – how can we maintain that we have true faith, a pure heart, a good conscience and we are filled with God's love?

Shoeboxes from South Australia in the past have been sent to places like the Philippines, Papua New Guinea, and Ukraine. It is humbling to think that a child—who may never have received a gift before—can open a box that's been packed by our very own hands.

Even more importantly, each shoebox is accompanied by literature that introduces children and their families to Jesus Christ. They are invited to take part in *The Greatest Journey*, a discipleship program where they learn about God's love and the good news of salvation. What a wonderful opportunity for us to be part of something that carries eternal impact!



In the rear hall, you'll find some gift suggestions you can include as well as the flatpack shoeboxes themselves and information guides you can take home.

Let's prayerfully consider how many children we can bless this year. Together, we can share not only the joy of a Christmas gift, but the even greater gift of God's love in Christ.

Since 2009 over 46 million shoebox recipients have participated in the 12-lesson discipleship course, *The Greatest Journey*. More than 23 million boys and girls have made decisions for Christ.

Last year, an astounding 57% of the children who attended made decisions for Christ!
